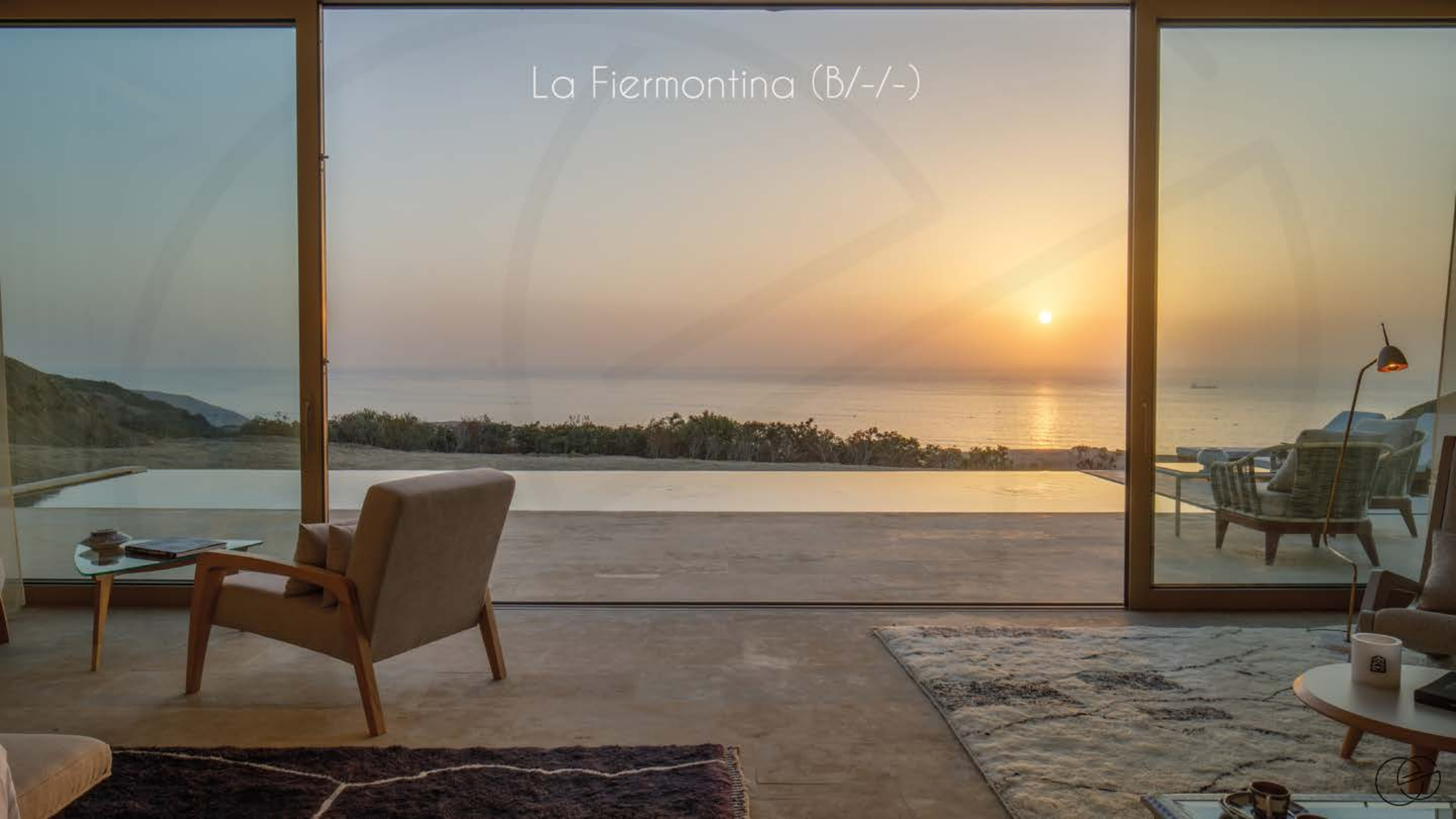

An open-air museum, Fes rivals Venice, Florence and Athens as a living universal heritage. The refinement of its palaces, the richness of its museums, the grandeur of its medersas which sheltered the greatest scholars of the Golden Age, the profusion of its mosques as many tributes to the greatness of God are, for the lovers of culture and arts, an invitation to the discovery constantly renewed.

Spiritual and cultural center of the Kingdom, city of a thousand facets, Fes remains intact in its splendor. Its priority is to preserve its traditions and the soul of its old stones. Its medina, classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, has kept its authenticity and original character for over 1,200 years.

Fes has inherited Arab nobility, Andalusian refinement, Jewish ingenuity and Berber tenacity. Its brilliant past, the respect of its tangible and intangible heritage and its aristocratic character, contribute to the obvious fascination that the city exerts on today's visitor. The jewels of Fes El Bali... The entire ancient city, Fes-el-Bali, is a real open-air museum. It contains countless masterpieces in its 9400 streets.

Meknes, the imperial city of Morocco, whose medina is classified as a universal heritage of humanity, envelops its visitors in its enchantment. A stay in its walls leaves an unforgettable memory where historical grandeur, sweetness of life and authentic flavors are mixed.

Located in the foothills of the Zerhoun massif, Volubilis takes its name from the Berber word Oualili, which refers to the colorful flower of the bindweed, a plant abundant in the region. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997, Volubilis is the largest archaeological site in Morocco with 18 hectares accessible to the public. The site owes its fame to the numerous mosaics that adorn the ancient dwellings.

Moulay Idriss founder of a kingdom and the city of Fes. He is nowadays adulated as a saint. His city, perched on a hillside, is housing his tomb which is an important pilgrimage place. The terrace of the Scorpion House features a breath-taking view of the holy white city."

The romans had shown the way ahead. Today French winemakers uphold the tradition, using their Bordeaux expertise, in this Middle Atlas Mountains region that sometimes recalls Tuscany. Reds, Whites, Rosés, Gris, enhance their grape varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Chardonnay, Marselan, Trempalino...that offer wines of superior quality. 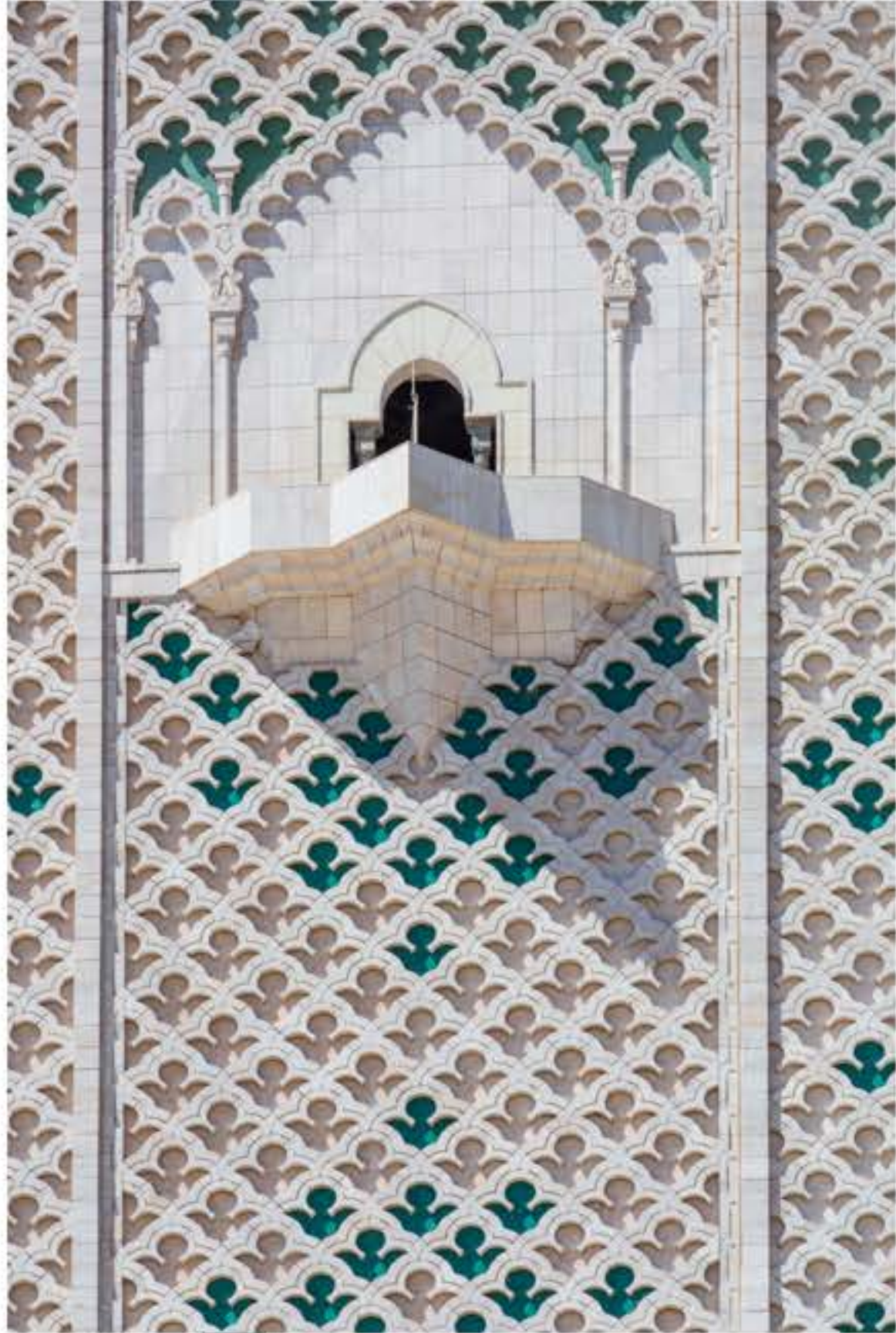

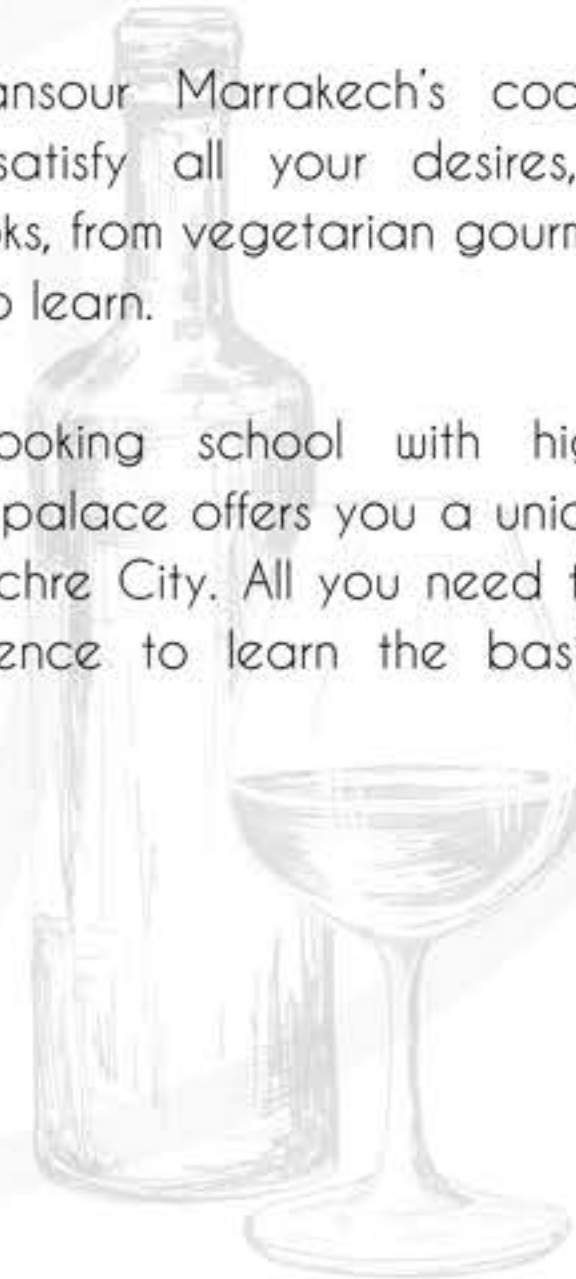

"Ride off the beaten path through the medina and the palm grove to make your way towards Dar El Sadaka.

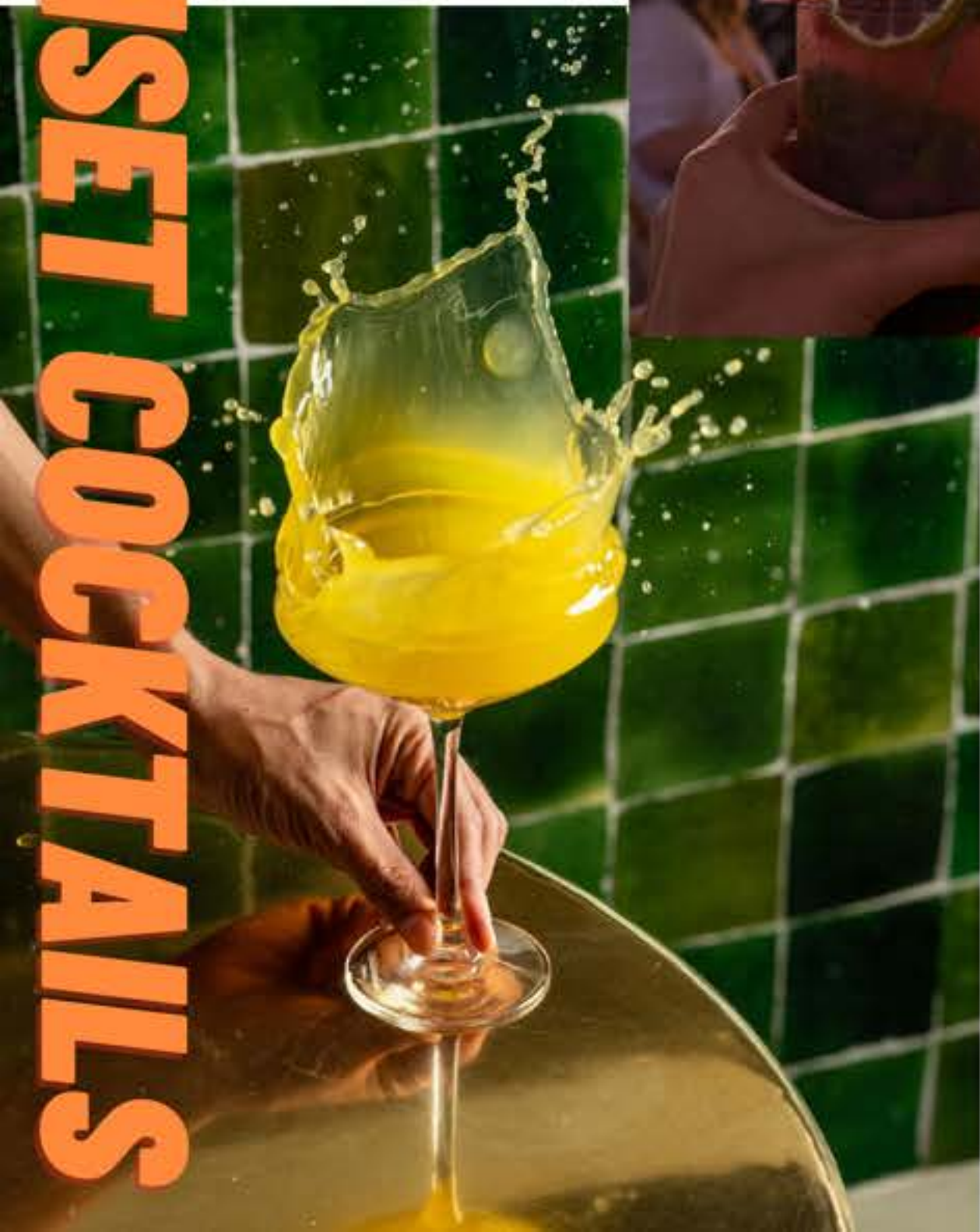

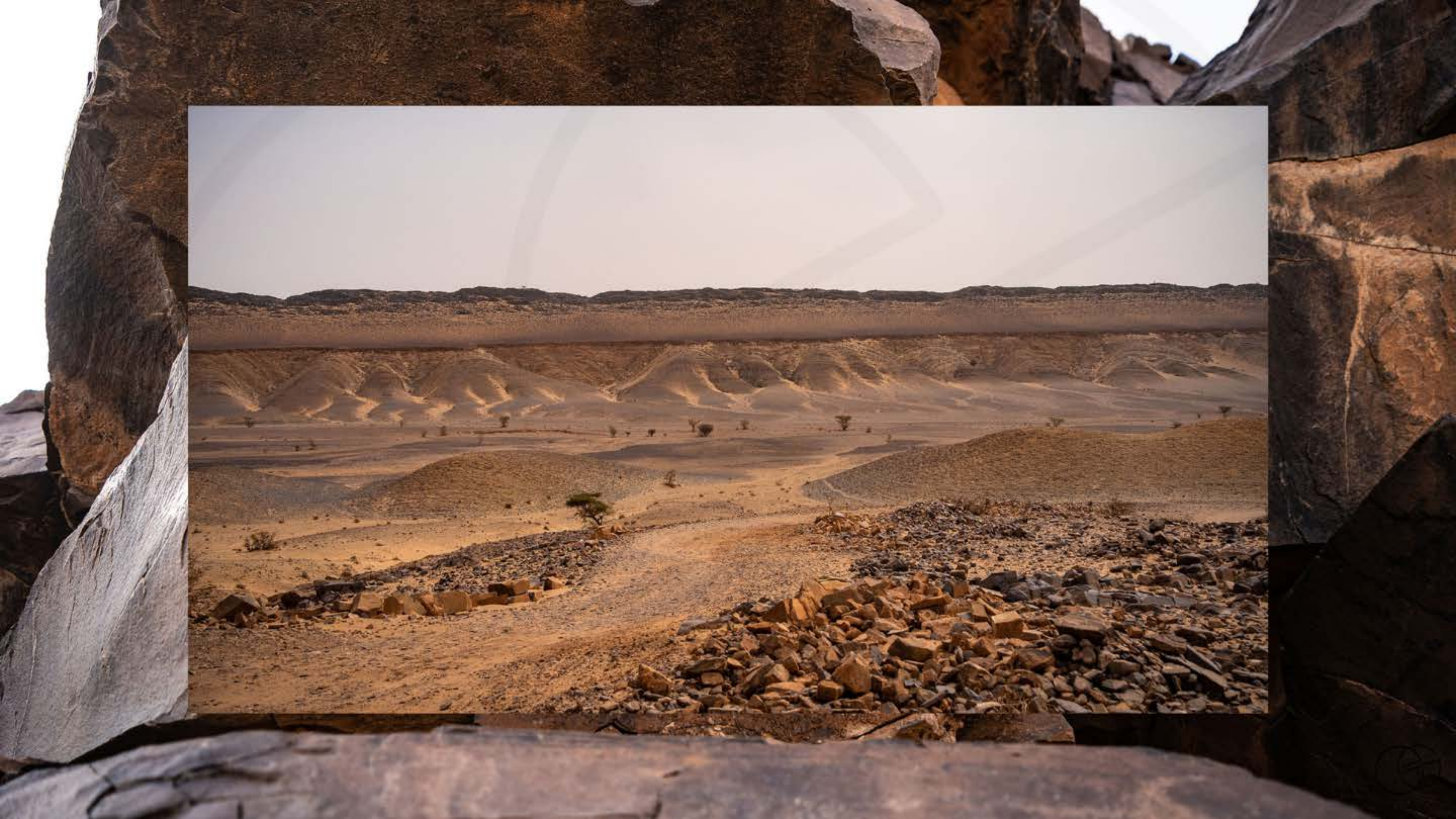
