Meknes, the imperial city of Morocco, whose medina is classified as a universal heritage of humanity, envelops its visitors in its enchantment. A stay in its walls leaves an unforgettable memory where historical grandeur, sweetness of life and authentic flavors are mixed.

Located in the foothills of the Zerhoun massif, Volubilis takes its name from the Berber word Oualili, which refers to the colorful flower of the bindweed, a plant abundant in the region. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997, Volubilis is the largest archaeological site in Morocco with 18 hectares accessible to the public. The site owes its fame to the numerous mosaics that adorn the ancient dwellings.

Moulay Idriss founder of a kingdom and the city of Fes. He is nowadays adulated as a saint. His city, perched on a hillside, is housing his tomb which is an important pilgrimage place. The terrace of the Scorpion House features a breath-taking view of the holy white city."

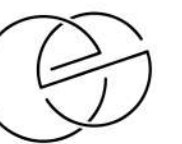

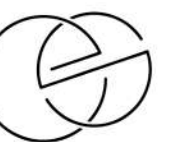


"Ride off the beaten path through the medina and the palm grove to make your way towards Dar El Sadaka.

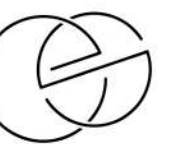

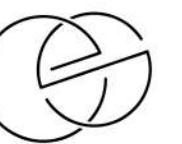

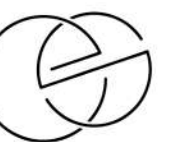

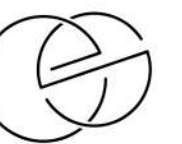

Berbers have preserved their way of life that can be rough at such high altitude. Their hospitality and smiles will illuminate your meeting with them.

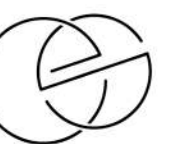
